Mission

To help Cabarrus County adults move toward wellness by providing comprehensive healthcare and pharmacy services.

Goals

To remove the barriers of limited financial resources and lack of health insurance by increasing access to healthcare and pharmacy services.

To increase the health stabilization of patients by providing primary care and pharmacy services.

We are our community's response to unmet healthcare needs in Cabarrus County.

Prevention and treatment of chronic health conditions will improve the work force and general health status of Cabarrus County which impacts economic growth and development. Healthy people can take care of themselves and their families making our communities healthier places to live.

CABARRUS COUNTY'S HEALTHCARE SAFETY NET

Clinic and pharmacy services are supported through a collaborative partnership with volunteers including physicians, pharmacists, dentists, medical support and administrative staff; Community Care Plan of Southern Piedmont; CMC-NorthEast; Cabarrus Health Alliance; Cabarrus Rowan Community Health Centers; MedAssist of North Carolina; and other community agencies.

WHO WE SERVE

Our patients have **NO** provision for healthcare within the Affordable Care Act (ACA) of 2010 due to lack of Medicaid expansion in our state. We treat low income uninsured working age adults that have high blood pressure, diabetes, heart disease, and other chronic health conditions. We serve patients who need access to healthcare and establishment of a medical home but have no access to healthcare coverage. By providing healthcare and medicine at no charge, we help our patients manage their chronic health conditions and keep them out of the emergency room and the hospital.

SERVICES AT COMMUNITY FREE CLINIC

- Medical care is provided on Tuesdays, Wednesday mornings, and Thursdays by our nurse practitioner and volunteer physicians.
- Medical care is provided on Tuesday evenings by volunteer physicians.
- Monthly specialty clinics.
- Pharmacy services are provided by our pharmacist on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday. Volunteer pharmacists provide services every Tuesday evening.
- Lab services are provided at no charge through LabCorp and CMC-NorthEast.
- Eligibility, enrollment, and recertification healthcare services for Cabarrus County CCP HealthNet.
- Eligibility, enrollment, and recertification of MedAssist (medication) services.
- CCP HealthNet care coordination services.

We are Keeping People Healthy

In addition to providing free medicine to its own clinical patients, the Community Free Clinic also provides pharmacy services to other uninsured people in our county. This service is provided through our in-house pharmacy which is a "point of entry" pharmacy for MedAssist of North Carolina.

The Clinic's pharmacy provides patient assistance medications and diabetic supplies to over 800 patients who are seen as charity care by area physicians.

The Community Free Clinic also works with Cabarrus Community Health Centers to prepare patient assistance program medications for their uninsured patients.
